

Glossary

Fitness-for-Safety Activity: Activities which licensees conduct on a routine basis to ensure safe operation of the nuclear installations and to ensure public health and safety.

Fitness-for-Safety Program: Programs which licensees implement to ensure safe operation of the nuclear installations and to ensure public health and safety. The programs are submitted to the Regulatory Authority and shall be approved by the Authority.

Note: The term "**Operational Safety Program**" is used in Japan's national report of "Convention on Nuclear Safety" for NPPs in the operation phase. The term "**Fitness-for-Safety Program**" is a generic expression for the operation and decommissioning phases. The contents of "**Fitness-for-Fitness Program**" are amended at the stages of fuel removal, fuel shipment, decontamination activity before dismantlement, storage and dismantlement.

Fitness-for-Safety Inspection: Inspections which the Regulatory Authority implements to inspect the licensee's implementation of the Fitness-for-Safety program. Inspections can be on a short-notice basis. This term is sometimes referred to as the "**Nuclear Safety Inspection**" or just the "**Safety Inspection.**"
